Lesson 1. SEEK AND YE SHALL FIND

(Thou Shalt Not Covet)

<u>Purpose</u>: a) To enable the child to get along with others by fostering an atmosphere free from coveting what another child has.

b) To introduce the concept of "looking" for the gifts that God has given us.

Materials: A toy and a chair

Presentation:

- 1) Two adults are needed. One has a toy and the other tries to take it away. The teacher explains that that was not the right way because it made someone sad. Then they show the right way: the second adult goes and finds a toy that no one is playing with.
- 2) One is sitting on a chair. The second adult tries to sit in the same chair. The teacher asks the class if "this is being kind?" Then they show the right way: the second adult goes and finds a chair that on one is sitting on.

Song: Seek and Ye Shall Find
